

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Lake Oroville State Recreation Area Low Water Ramp Update

Due to conditions caused by the low water at Lake Oroville, Bidwell Launch Ramp will be closed. Current conditions

drive vehicles to have difficulty launching vessels from the gravel ramp. Bidwell Marina will still be open and available to assist visitors. The Bidwell Gravel Launch Ramp will reopen when lake levels rise above elevation

DWR's Bidwell Canyon Stage 3 concrete ramp exten-

sion project continues to move forward with work expected to start this week and continue through December. You will see the Stage 3 Ramp Parking Lot closed to the public until work is completed.

Visitors are still able to launch from the Department of Water Resources' (DWR),

Spillway Low Water Gravel Boat Ramp. The Spillway Low Water Gravel Boat Ramp area has a boarding float, or dock,

and lighting set up for this area. The area has been re-grav-


eled, but four-wheeldrive vehicles are still required if accessing or launching from this area. This is now the only accessible launch ramp currently on Lake Oroville.

The South Forebay and Afterbay will also remain open for power-boating recreation.

Launching is available for non-motorized watercraft at the Diversion Pool, below the dam, and the North Forebay west of Highway 70.

Bidwell Canyon and Lake Oroville Marina offer a wide variety of boat rentals to enjoy the uncrowded atmosphere provided on the lake.

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New Traffic Signals At Oro Dam Blvd Orange Avenue And Acacia Avenue

The City is nearing completion of the traffic signals project at Oro Dam Boulevard and Orange Avenue. The signals have been operational but are currently in an "all way stop" mode pending the completion of final signal timing programming. The City scheduled the official "turning on" of the signals for December 21, 2015. Previously (and for many decades) the intersection configuration required vehicles to stop at either of two sets of stop markings, stop bars and stop signs that were located in the middle of the intersection. The stop markings have been removed and will be replaced with new "straight through and turning arrow" markings to remind drivers that the intersection interior is fully protected and that stopping is not allowed.

Drivers are advised not to stop within the interior of the intersection as each road segment will now have fully protected through and turning movements through the entire reconfigured intersection. When vehicles from any individual road segment receive a green light, vehicles at the other four road segments will face a red light and will be stopped. The turn on signal timing parameters have been set to provide adequate green time for vehicles from all five road segments to safely proceed through the entire intersection, regardless of the desired turning movements.

Due to the unique geometry of the five road segments that make up the intersection, it may take some drivers some time to become familiar with the new intersection configuration. Drivers are reminded to navigate this intersection no differently than a conventional 4-way intersection.
