

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
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
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## **Uncle Sam Wants You To Save For Retirement**

(NAPSI)—If you ever feel your finances are too stretched to save for retirement, you're not alone—and there could be good news for you. The Saver's Credit—a little-known tax credit made available by the IRS to low- to moderate-income workers—could make saving for retirement more affordable than you think. It may reduce your federal income taxes when you save for retirement through a qualified retirement plan or an individual retirement account (IRA).

"The Saver's Credit is a fantastic tax credit because it may help you reduce your tax bill while saving for retirement. It offers eligible workers an added incentive to save for retirement on top of the benefits of tax-deferred savings when they contribute to a 401(k), 403(b) or IRA," says Catherine Collinson, president of nonprofit Transamerica Center for Retirement Studies®.

#### Here's how it works:

#### 1. Check Your Eligibility

Depending on your filing status and income level, you may qualify for a nonrefundable credit of up to \$1,000 (or \$2,000 if filing jointly) on your federal income taxes for that year when you contribute to a 401(k), 403(b) or similar retirement plan, an IRA or myRA.

Single filers with an Adjusted Gross Income (AGI) of up to \$30,500 in 2015 or \$30,750 in 2016 are eligible. For the head of a household, the AGI limit is \$45,750 in 2015 or \$46,125 in 2016. For those who are married and file a joint return, the AGI limit is \$61,000 in 2015 or \$61,500 in 2016.

You must be 18 years or older by January 1 and cannot be a full-time student or be claimed as a dependent on another person's tax return. If you fit within these parameters, the Saver's Credit may be for you.

#### 2. Save for Retirement

Save for retirement in your employer's retirement plan, if offered, or in an IRA. In general, for every dollar you contribute to a qualified retirement plan or IRA (up to the lesser of the limits permitted by

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an employer-sponsored plan or the IRS), you defer that amount from your current overall taxable income on your federal tax returns—and you may also qualify for the Saver's Credit.

### 3. File Your Tax Return and Claim the Credit

When you prepare your federal tax returns, you can claim your Saver's Credit by subtracting this tax credit from your federal income taxes owed.

Most workers who are eligible to claim the Saver's Credit are also eligible to take advantage of the IRS Free File program for taxpayers with an AGI of \$62,000 or less. Thirteen commercial software companies make their tax preparation software available for free through the Free File program at www.irs.gov/FreeFile.

- If you are using tax preparation software, including those offered through the IRS Free File program at www.irs.gov, use Form 1040, Form 1040A or Form 1040NR. If your software has an interview process, be sure to answer questions about the Saver's Credit, also referred to as the Retirement Savings Contributions Credit and/or Credit for Qualified Retirement Savings Contributions.
- If you are preparing your tax returns manually, complete Form 8880, the Credit for Qualified Retirement Savings Contributions, to determine your exact credit rate and amount. Then transfer the amount to the designated line on Form 1040, Form 1040A or 1040NR.
- If you are using a professional tax preparer, be sure to ask about the Saver's Credit.
- Consider having any refund you receive directly deposited to an IRA to further boost your retirement savings.

Please note that the Saver's Credit is not available with Form 1040EZ.

The 16th Annual Transamerica Retirement Survey found that just 25 percent of American workers with annual household incomes of less than \$50,000 are aware that the credit exists. Don't overlook Uncle Sam's Saver's Credit; it may help you pay less in your current federal income taxes while saving for retirement.

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

## **Deter Smartphone Thefts** and **Protect Your Data**

(NAPSI)—As Americans increasingly prefer mobile-first lifestyles, our mobile devices hold personal data that must be protected. That's why the wireless industry is proactively working to help you protect your smartphones and your information.

CTIA and participating wireless companies developed the "Smartphone Anti-Theft Voluntary Commitment" that will, at no cost to consumers:

- Remote wipe the owner's data in the event it is lost or stolen;
- Render the smartphone inoperable to an unauthorized user; and
- Prevent reactivation without the owner's permission.

Yet if the smartphone is recovered by the owner, the data on the smartphone can be restored to the extent feasible.

In addition to the voluntary commitment, CTIA and its member companies are individually and collectively developing consumer education campaigns to remind consumers about the numerous apps and features—many for free—available today to help deter theft and protect your personal information. These efforts are clearly working; there was a more than 20 percent increase in PIN and password usage from 2012 to 2015 according to a recent survey.

While the wireless industry is actively helping protect consumers, it's important that users also take some important and simple steps to protect their smartphones and their personal information.

BEFORE your smartphone is lost or stolen:

- 1. Be Aware. Know your surroundings and be cognizant of your smartphone use behavior. Try not to call attention to your smartphone, leave it lying around or let strangers "borrow" it.
- 2. Lock It. Set a hard-to-guess password to protect your device and change it regularly.

- 3. Add Apps. A number of apps can remotely track, lock or erase/wipe personal information on your smartphone. In addition, some remotely trigger an alarm so people know their smartphone is stolen or photograph the thief so you can send it to police. CTIA developed a list of apps available on Apple (iOS), Android, Black-Berry, and Windows platforms so you can choose the best one(s) for you.
- 4. Save It (Again). If you have photos, e-mails, contacts, videos or anything else that you want to make sure is available if your smartphone is ever lost or stolen, save it somewhere else, such as a computer, USB drive or cloud service.
- 5. Insure It. Consider insuring your device through your wireless provider or a third-party entity so if it is lost or stolen, replacement is covered.

AFTER your smartphone is lost or stolen:

- 1. Report It. Immediately notify your wireless provider to avoid incurring charges. Tell the police what tracking or similar apps you have installed that may help them. If your device is lost, instruct your provider to put a "hold" on your account.
- 2. Locate It. Never attempt to recover your smartphone on your own, warns CTIA,; your safety should always be your No. 1 priority. If you've installed apps to remotely track your smartphone, however, activate them from a safe location and remotely lock your smartphone.
- 3. Erase It. If you have sensitive information relating to finances, health or work, or you believe your smartphone won't be returned, "remote wipe" it-similar to resetting it to its default settings. If you stored any passwords on your smartphone for email, financial accounts or remote work access, make sure you change them.

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




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
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

#### **How To Pay Less Next Tax Time** (Legally)

(NAPSI)—Getting a big check may not always be a good thing. For example, if you receive a large tax refund from the IRS, it means you paid out too much in income tax the year before and, essentially, lent your money to the government interest free.

Fortunately, a talk with a licensed tax specialist before the end of the year may help you avoid both that and having to pay a lot next tax time.

#### Here are a few hints on how:

- Make sure your W-4 form at work is up to date and filled out in your favor. Does it have the correct number for your dependents?
- Institute, increase or max out retirement contributions. Contribute more to your 401(k) to reduce your taxable income and your tax bill. If you don't have one, or an IRA, now might be a good time to
- Be generous. Charitable gifts and certain presents to relatives may yield tax benefits. In addition to money gifts, donating clothes, toys and household items to charity can lead to a tax deduction. Keep a list of what you gave and its fair market value and get a receipt from the organization. You may also be able to deduct travel and other expenses of volunteering.
- Mix business with pleasure. If you can combine a vacation and business trip, you may be able to deduct part of the unreimbursed expenses spent on business, such as airfare and part of your hotel bill.
- Use health care to improve your wealth. If you can, tap into a medical reimbursement account or flex plan at work that lets you divert part of your salary, pretax, to an account from which to pay medi-
- · Looking for work? Job search expenses such as agency fees, résumé printing, career counseling costs and travel related to the effort may be deductible even if you didn't find a new job. If you do find one that meets the 50-mile test, you may be able to deduct your moving expenses.
- Go green. Some energy-saving devices and appliances also come with a tax
- Be smart, go to school. You may be able to get a tax credit on 100 percent of the first \$2,000 spent on certain college expenses and 25 percent of the next \$2,000 for up to \$2,500 per student.
- · Get more good advice from an enrolled agent and member of the National Association of Enrolled Agents—a group of licensed tax practitioners who focus solely on taxation year-round. To find one nearby, call (855) 880-6232 or visit www. eatax.org.
