# Come Join the RCD in Helping Keep Our Roadways Clean

Hello past and future volunteers, I am pleased to introduce myself as the new AmeriCorps Conservation Associate with the Butte County Resource Conservation District (BCRCD). I will be hosting my first Adopt-A-Highway Cleanup on December 10th, 2014 and would be thrilled if you can join me along with volunteers from the Natural Resource Conservation Service (NRCS) to help remove litter that has accumulated along Butte County roadways. So far, your efforts have amounted to 200 volunteer hours and nearly 500 pounds of trash removed from the four mile stretch of Highway 99 shared by the NRCS and the BCRCD over the course of last year. My goal for this year is to improve on those efforts by increasing the amount of volunteer hours utilized thus leading to hundreds more pounds of trash removed from the roadways.

Volunteers will be needed from 9 a.m. - 12 p.m. to help cleanup litter. If you cannot make it to the clean up, please share the attached flyer below with other potential volunteers. Let's make a positive statement to visitors and residents regarding litter along Butte County roadways. If you are interested in helping, please contact me! We will be meeting at 9 a.m. at the intersection of Highway 99 and Oroville Dam Blvd. (Hwy 162 east) in the parking lot west of Highway 99 (see map). Please dress for safety and the weather. Long pants, long sleeves, and sturdy boots are highly recommended. Also, bring water and a positive attitude and the rest will be provided including snacks, safety gear and work supplies.

The mission of the Butte County Resource Conservation District is to protect, enhance, and support Butte County natural resources and agriculture by working with willing land owners and citizens through education, land management, and on-the-ground projects.

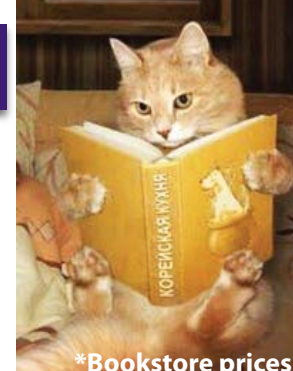

It consists of 159 parcels totaling 192.56 acres.

## PERIPHERAL NEUROPATHY

Being both a Neuropathist and a Diabetic, the subject of Peripheral Neuropathy holds particular interest for me. What is Peripheral Neuropathy? It's pain, numbness, burning, etc., of the extremities.

Most people associate Neuropathy with Diabetes; but it can stem from multiple issues; such as addictions, chemotherapy, injury/trauma, frostbite, malnutrition, etc. With over 100 different types of neuropathy, the term can even loosely apply to countless conditions; such as, Carpal Tunnel Syndrome! 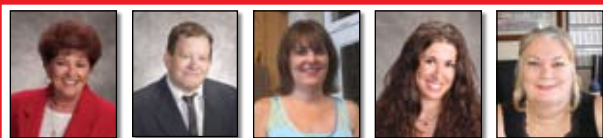

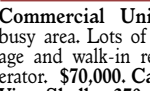
